

Conditions of Entry 2019



To enter this category you must fulfil the following criteria

Check first . . .

1. Be aged 18-25 years at the close of entries for this Awards Programme year.
 2. Be currently employed on a dairy farm in a permanent full time position, and remain so until the conclusion of your regional judging.
 3. Have not been employed for more than three (3) years on a dairy farm from the age of 18 either continuously or in total as at 1st June 2018.
 4. Be a NZ citizen or NZ resident at close of entries for this Awards Programme year of which proof may be required **OR** Entrants with a NZ work visa are eligible to enter DTOTY if they:
 - Hold a valid New Zealand work visa at entry and at each stage of judging * **
 - Have been employed full-time for a minimum of 2 years on a New Zealand dairy farm as at 1st October 2018
 - Meet all other eligibility requirements for entry.
- * Preliminary and Final regional judging dates are available on www.dairyindustryawards.co.nz and from DTOTY Regional Team Leaders.
- ** Valid New Zealand work visa needs to be sighted by Head Judge at each judging
5. Have an Individual Employment Agreement for your current position of which proof may be required.

Keep going . . .

6. Have no equity in any dairy farming business.
7. You can enter only one category run by the NZDIA in any one year.
8. Agree that any information provided as part of your entry, including the National Finalists Video may be made public in the interests of the Awards and use is at the sole discretion of the NZDIA.
9. You must not be a previous winner of any NZDIA category.
10. Regional Winners must attend the Dairy Industry Awards Field Day to be held on the property of the Share Farmer of the Year winner in your region. You will be required to give a short presentation covering information specified by the NZDIA.
11. Regional winners are required to enter the national final of their respective category. If circumstances dictate a regional winner is unable to fulfil their obligation, that region will not be represented in that category.
12. The regional and national winners agree to make themselves available to the national sponsors for promotional purposes.
13. All entrant details will be held by the NZDIA and may be used for promotional purposes by the NZDIA and their national sponsors.
14. Promotional and advertising rights are at the sole discretion of the NZDIA.

Almost at the finish line . .

15. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
16. Prizes are not transferable or redeemable for cash.
17. No person may use or approve the use of the NZDIA name or logo or the names or logos of its associated categories for the purpose of the promotion of any person, product or service without the written approval of the General Manager.
18. The NZDIA Executive reserves the right to deny entry to a potential entrant, to deem an entrant ineligible, and to terminate an entrant's entry in the category if the entrant's behaviour is deemed to bring, or potentially bring, the Awards into disrepute.
19. The NZDIA Executive reserves the right to cancel a category in any region should continuing be deemed unfeasible. All such decisions are made solely at the Executive's discretion and no correspondence will be entered into.
20. Entrants should be aware that it is their responsibility to ensure their practices comply with all legal requirements including but not limited to: environment, employment, animal welfare, health & safety and district and regional council regulations.
